**Scheduled speakers for the May 5 meeting were: Mayor Linda Kochmar of Federal Way to speak on the state of the city, and South King County Fire & Rescue Chief Al Church.**

At this meeting, the 30th LD Democrats **voted to endorse** initiatives **I-1068** to decriminalize the possession and use of marijuana and **I-1098** to establish an income tax on "High Earners" (individuals incomes in excess of \$200,000 per year or couples incomes in excess of \$400,000). **This initiative would also reduce the State's portion of property tax by 20% and eliminate the Business and Occupation Tax.**

## Meeting Report from the Federal Way City Council

Tim Burns read into the record of the FW City Council on May 4 a statement in which he urged the City Council to adopt a proclamation or resolution to boycott the State of Arizona as a result of that State's recent passage of the "Papers Please" law.

The City Councils of Seattle and Tacoma are scheduled to address this issue. Los Angeles has voted to "Boycott Arizona".

Delegates representing the **Washington State Labor Council's affiliated unions voted unanimously Saturday to oppose this initiative, so the WSLC will immediately begin distributing** information to unions and rank-and-file members explaining why I-1082 would be bad for our state's working families -- and its employers.

.... insurance companies sponsoring I-1082 **plan to spend millions** to convince Washington voters that I-1082 will "save jobs." **But here's the truth:**

**I-1082 privatization will drive up employers' costs.** The same profit-minded insurance companies that gouge us on health insurance will do the same with workers' compensation. Rates will skyrocket for employers that want to stay in our public non-profit system because private insurers will cherry-pick low-risk employers from the system.

## **Initiative 1082 (Continued)**

-- **I-1082 privatization will kill jobs and lower wages.** Ending worker contributions to the system, as I-1082 does, means a 25% rate hike for employers. Not only will this cost precious jobs amid a recession, employers will cut wages to try to make up the difference..

-- **I-1082 privatization will add a profit motive to our public non-profit system.** Wall Street-based insurance companies like AIG (America's biggest private workers' compensation insurer) are driven by the bottom line, not by public service. They try to deny injured workers' claims and charge employers as much as they can get away with.

-- **I-1082 privatization will force injured workers to fight the giant insurance companies for their benefits.** These insurers routinely deny claims -- just as they do for health insurance -- and they have deep pockets to drag out the legal process through endless appeals.

-- **I-1082 privatization will lead to taxpayer bailouts to maintain employers' coverage and workers' benefits when insurance companies go bankrupt.**

This has repeatedly happened in California and other states -- costing taxpayers billions -- after insurers temporarily charged artificially low rates to try to gain market share and then failed, leaving the state to pick up the tab.

### [Since spill, feds have given 27 waivers to oil companies in gulf](#)

Since the Deepwater Horizon oil drilling rig exploded on April 20, the Obama administration has granted oil and gas companies at least 27 exemptions from doing in-depth environmental studies of oil exploration and production in the Gulf of Mexico. The waivers were granted despite President Barack Obama's vow that his administration would launch a "relentless response effort" to stop the leak and prevent more damage to the gulf. One of them was dated Friday — the day after Interior Secretary Ken Salazar said he was temporarily halting offshore drilling

### [Oil spill: BP had wrong diagram to close blowout preventer](#)

In the days after an oil well spun out of control in the Gulf of Mexico, BP engineers tried to activate a huge piece of underwater safety equipment but failed because the device had been so altered that diagrams BP got from the equipment's owner didn't match the supposedly failsafe device's configuration. That meant that when engineers thought they were activating the blowout preventer to crimp the well's pipe, they were actually activating a piece of test equipment.

### [Gulf oil spill still out to sea, but odor has reached shore](#)

Areas of Bay St. Louis, Waveland and Gulfport reported pervasive petroleum smells Tuesday. It was described variously as a burned-plastic odor, odd waxy smell and the smell of diesel exhaust. It's to be expected, officials said, with all that crude oil in the Gulf.
