Chair's Report

Official Notice - At the regular November 7 membership meeting of the 30th LD Democrats several bylaw amendments will be proposed. Most of these are due to the redistricting of the 30th LD to include a portion of Pierce County. Since we were previously entirely in King County, we currently have no provisions to adhere to any Pierce County Democratic Central Committee Bylaws nor do we have provisions for representation to the PCDCC. This needs to be corrected in our bylaws prior to our reorganization meeting in January, thus the proposed amendments. In addition there are amendments to move a portion of the endorsement process to Standing Rules, a change to the procedure to fill vacant elected positions, and some "housekeeping" language changes.

The amendments can be amended by the membership from the floor at the meeting. Any changes to the current bylaws will require a majority vote of those members present and voting.

November 6 General Election - By now you should have received the 30th LD Endorsement Mailer listing of the candidates and issues endorsed by the membership. This was a huge and new undertaking for our LD. The mailer was sent to 10,265 households in 2 Congressional Districts (8th and 9th) and 2 Counties (King and Pierce) within the 30th LD and included 20 candidates and 13 issues. Thanks to Dan Turley and Richard Champion for their magnificent work in putting this together and to Beverly Warnke for her generous financial donation to get it printed and mailed.

This election is vitally important for the future of our nation, state and district. Be sure to return your ballot by November 6 and encourage your friends, family and neighbors to vote for our endorsed candidates and issues. Personal contact is the most effective way to support our positions.

Change of location for the December 5 Holiday Party - At our October 3rd meeting the membership approved moving our Holiday Party to the Federal Way Community Center.

Changes of future membership meetings -

Also at the October membership meeting the body voted to move our regular meetings to Sacajawea Middle School and to change the dates of our January and April meetings to the 2nd Wednesday of those months. Since then we have been informed that Sacajawea is not available to us for these meetings. We are researching other venues and will make that information available when it is known.

Reorganization Meetings - The "reorg" meetings of King County and Pierce County Democratic Central Committees and the 30th LD are approaching. King County is scheduled for December 8, 2012 at the IAM District 751 Hall in South Seattle starting at 1pm. Pierce County is to be determined. The reorg for the 30th LD is scheduled for January 9, 2013. At each reorg the officers of that organization will be elected and bylaws approved.

In the case of the 30th LD, the Chair, Vice-Chair, State Committee man and woman, County Delegates and LAC Chair will be elected by the PCOs who were elected in the August 2012 primary election. The Secretary and Treasurer will be elected by all members present and voting. There will not be proxies, you must be present to vote.

All PCOs are encouraged to attend their respective County "Reorg" and the 30th LD Reorg. The 30th LD will also accept applications to appoint PCOs at our "reorg" between the elections of the LAC Chair and the Secretary and Treasurer.

Our current 50/50 raffle - Tickets are not being sold at the expected rate. This is a major

fundraising project for the 30th LD. The winner will receive half of the gross receipts with a minimum guarantee of \$250.00 and a possible \$1300.00 if all tickets are sold. For those who have signed out tickets, please return the stubs and money as soon as possible and sign out more tickets to sell. For those who have not signed out tickets as yet, please contact Tim Burns to help reach our goal. The drawing of the winning ticket will take place at our December 5 Holiday Party. Time to sell the remaining tickets is of the essence. The tickets are \$2.00 each and can be sold to anyone over 18 years of age.
