Representative Roger Freeman On Wednesday, October 29, Representative Freeman passed away after a nearly 2 year battle with cancer. Roger was an incumbent Representative of the 30th LD in the Washington State Legislature and was running for re-election. During his first and only term in Olympia, Roger was successful in passing more bills than many legislators do in several terms. He was a very effective representative of our district and our party. The 30th LD Democrats endorsed and supported him in his campaigns for Federal Way City Council in 2010 and State Representative in both 2012 and this year.

Roger is survived by his wife, Sonya, and two children. At this time, the date, location and time of services have not been announced. We mourn the loss of Roger to our community, State, Democratic Party and especially to his family.

Despite his passing, we will continue to work for, and anticipate, his re-election. If Roger is re-elected, it will trigger a procedure to appoint his replacement wherein the Democratic Precinct Committee Officers in the 30th District will select three candidates, one of whom will be appointed by the County Councils in King and Pierce to fill the vacancy until the 2015 election cycle.

In the 30th LD the elected PCOs will select the Chair, 2 Vice Chairs, State Committee Man and Woman, King County Male and Female Delegates and Alternates, Legislative Action Committee Chair, 3 Pierce County Delegates and our Endorsements Chair and renew our bylaws. All members present will elect our Secretary and Treasurer. The proposed agenda and rules will be published in next month’s newsletter.
