**Crunch Time**-The general election is less than 40 days from now (November 8) and we need, yes need, all hands on deck to win up and down the ballot. There is still a lot of work to do, and the candidates cannot do it alone. Our list of endorsed candidates and issues is elsewhere in this newsletter. In order to be endorsed by the 30<sup>th</sup> LD Democrats, a candidate or issue must receive at least 60% approval by the members present and voting when the endorsement is considered. We do not take these endorsements lightly. Most of the candidates and issues have been through an interview process with our endorsement committee and are then recommended to the membership for consideration. Many of the candidates have attended and spoken at our monthly meetings.

How can you help? The most effective campaigning is one-to-one, candidate to voter. Our local 30<sup>th</sup> District candidates, Mike Pellicciotti and Kristine Reeves are doorbelling their shoes off to meet as many voters as they possibly can. But what can you do? Devote at least one hour a week to knock on doors, phone call to voters, wave signs at intersections, put up yard signs or just talk with your family, friends and neighbors. Every vote will be important. Mike and Kristine each won their respective primary elections and are poised to win the general election, but need your assistance to be victorious on November 8.

The Orca Bay Seafood Freezer project has been the talk of the Council Chambers for the last month. Citizen comments keep coming in and asking Mayor Ferrell and the Council to do something. ## State Committee Meeting

The Washington State Democrat Central Committee (WSDCC) held its Fall 2016 meeting on September 17<sup>th</sup> in Yakima. Ginny Leach and Jim Zanetti attended.

The WSDCC nominated candidates in a number of partisan races. A full list will be available at the October 5<sup>th</sup> 30<sup>th</sup> LD meeting.

The WSDCC approved an amendment to the Charter of the Democratic Party of Washington State that establishes a process by which future charter and bylaws amendments will be considered by the WSDCC or the State Convention.
