Ballots must be postmarked on or before November 8 to be valid (post offices may pick up the last mail for the day prior to the 8pm deadline). Ballot drop boxes will be sealed at 8pm on Election Day.

If you have already voted, thank you. Please encourage family, friends and neighbors to vote as well.

Our candidates are working hard to be elected this year and could use your help to call friendly voters, knock on doors, wave signs at intersections, place yard signs or enter data in a computer. Every vote is important; Kristine Reeves won her primary election by less than 1/2 vote per precinct. We cannot be complacent if we want to retain Governor Inslee, Senator Murray and Democratic control of the State House. A special bonus is the opportunity to break the "glass ceiling" and finally elect a woman President of the U.S.
