2016 Election Results Washington State certified the results of the 2016 election on November 29. While there is tremendous disappointment regarding the nationwide election of Donald Trump as President, in Washington State Democrats did well. The 30th LD Democrats endorsed 36 candidates and issues and were correct on 28 races (Hillary Clinton won Washington and we endorsed both the winner and loser in 3 races).

Mike Pellicciotti and Kristine Reeves won both the State Representative positions in the 30th LD unseating incumbents Linda Kochmar and Teri Hickel by 4325 and 1082 votes respectively. Their wins maintained the 50-48 Democratic majority in the State House and Lisa Wellmann's win in the 41st LD Senate race narrowed the Republican majority in the State Senate to 25-24. Thanks to Mike and Kristine for running, being great candidates and working so hard to win these seats. And thank you to all who supported their candidacy.

2017 Election Cycle Elections are held every year; in 2017 the emphasis is on county, municipal, school board and other offices which can be the bench for candidates desiring higher office. Those interested in being candidates should be preparing for the election now and our endorsement process will begin soon after the New Year.

Precinct Committee Officers (PCOs) Effective December 1 the PCOs who were elected as a result of the August primary election take office. The first official duties of the PCOs are electing the leadership of County and Legislative District officers who will serve for the next 2 years and approving the bylaws of those organizations. Persons interested in being appointed to PCO may submit an application (available on our website www.30thdemswa.org) which will be acted upon after the LD reorganization.

Reorganization Meeting On January 4, 2017 the 30th LD Democrats will hold our biennial reorganization meeting where all officers are selected and the bylaws approved. It is imperative to choose wisely as the future and progress of the local organization is at stake. Historically the meeting is conducted by representatives of the King County Democrats. All current (as of December 1) PCOs are encouraged to participate in electing our new officers. The available offices are included elsewhere in this newsletter. Members will elect the Secretary and Treasurer. The "official call" will be sent soon and include the proposed agenda and rules for the meeting.

From the Chair (Continued)

From the 30th LD Bylaws Article VII Section 1:

Officers of The 30th District Democrats elected in accordance with Article VI, Sec. 2 shall be: Chair, 1st Vice-Chair, 2nd Vice-Chair, State Committeeman, State Committeewoman, KCDCC Executive Board Male and Female Representative and their corresponding alternates, Three (3) PCDC Executive Board Representatives (at least one representative of each gender whenever possible), Endorsements Chair, Legislative Action Committee (LAC) Chair, and LAC Alternate. Both King and Pierce Counties must be represented among the offices of Chair, 1st Vice-Chair, and 2nd Vice-Chair.

From the 30th LD Bylaws Article III, Section 1

All elected and appointed 30th District Precinct Committee Officers are members of the 30th District Democrats.

And Article 5, Section 5 c

All Precinct Committee Officers shall be encouraged to pay dues.

From the 30th LD Bylaws Article III section 5 a:

General members shall be eligible to vote and run for office twenty (20) days after payment or waiver of dues, or for those who were members during the previous year, immediately upon payment of dues.
