## KCDCC Report

(April & May 2017)

May was a five Tuesday month thus allowing time to report on the May executive board meeting as well as the April meeting.

April: 1) Within the meeting, the Chair called for an executive session. For those who don't know what an executive session is, (I didn't), here is a brief summary: a) all non-voting attendees were requested to leave, the doors closed, and speakers talked without a "mic" to avoid people out in the hall from hearing; b) the Chair informed us that he was going to speak on three confidential matters that we could not divulge to anyone, and if we did he was going to be very (stern look) unhappy (this left me dazed, what happens if I am summoned to a grand-jury, do I take the fifth?); and c) we were told what's what but could do absolutely nothing with it - now you know!

2) The revised bylaws and rules were presented to be voted on by the members; however, before we could vote on the new bylaws there were at least three parliamentary moves that allowed an endorsement to take place (if this confuses the reader, that's ok, I asked Frank James more than once if he knew what the hell was going on, he didn't). BUT! Our own Allison Fine made a strong argument against this razzle-dazzle move; unfortunately, the argument convinced only me and a handful of voting others. NOTE. May: The big event at May's executive board meeting was the voting on a slate-of-candidates (18) put forward by the King County Democrats Endorsement committee and on candidates that for whatever reason, were not endorsed. Of those 18, a motion to pull a handful of those candidates was made. Each failed and the slate passed.
